



Custom Android App Loading

The IFPxx02-V7 IFP is based on open-source Android operating system. It is possible to install custom Android applications by using the following steps.

1. Using a trusted source, download or retrieve the application (.APK). You can install from a USB drive (format for FAT32) or from the IFP memory.
2. Make sure the Android operating system has “unknown sources” enabled. Follow instructions in the The V7 IFP Admin Menu to enable this. (Using the IFP remote control, enter **INPUT > 1 > 3 > 7 > 9**, then go to **Android Setting**, and change **Unknown Sources** to **On**).
3. Now you can open the file from the IFP using the built in Finder app.

Important Notes:

- **V7 will not provide technical support or guarantee interoperability of custom Android applications.**
- **Currently, only 32-bit apps will work with the V7 IFP. 64-bit apps cannot be installed.**
- **Apps should only be installed from the finder file manager.**
